No functions to be booked on **Sundays** or **Public Holidays**.

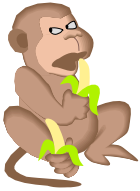
VERY IMPORTANT

- ❖ Exclusive use is only granted for the area under roof.
- ❖ The pool area and additional braai facilities are available between 06:00 & 21:00 for the use of other residents of Estate 2 and have to be shared.
- ❖ Flashing lights and PA Systems are **NOT ALLOWED**. We ask that consideration be given to residents residing nearby the Community Centres.
- ❖ No music is permitted at Community Centres.
- ❖ Besides the community centre pool, *no water activities, waterslides or foam slides allowed.*
- ❖ No animals or reptiles, horses/ponies, Carousel swings and quad bikes allowed.
- ❖ Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- ❖ All functions must be booked through the MECCEMA 2 office *one week in advance*.
- ❖ The responsibility of *cleaning up and removing of rubbish, etc. will lie with the resident who booked the community centre.*
- ❖ Keys for the Greenbrier Community Centre can be collected from the Control Centre at Gate 5 and must be returned immediately after the function.
- ❖ Community Centres will be open between the hours of *6am to 9pm*
- ❖ MECCEMA 2 will post a Security Guard for all evening functions and at their discretion for any other function, the cost thereof will be for your account.
- ❖ All residents (Owners and Tenants) have the right to use the Community Centres.
- ❖ The Community Centres are for the benefit of the MECCE 2 community. No Weddings, Religious/Cultural meetings, Business Functions, Formal Functions or meetings for gain (Tupperware sales, Sales Presentations etc) will be approved.
- ❖ No whole day bookings will be approved.

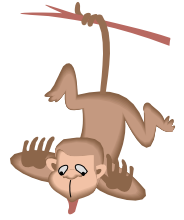

Monkeys visit this area so please do not leave food unattended



It is safe to be near monkeys provided that you follow these instructions:

- Use the hose reels provided to spray monkeys if they are trying to get to your food or food area
- **Do not feed** monkeys.
- Children need **not be afraid** of monkeys but must **never try to touch** them
- **Do not go near a mother** monkey if she has **her baby** nearby and do not go near the babies
- **Do not run away** from monkeys – they will chase you (they think you are playing catchers)
- **Do not throw objects** at monkeys – this makes them panic / they are then unpredictable
- **Do not shoot** monkeys (with paintball guns or any other guns)
- **Do not shout** at monkeys – this scares them, they will then think you want to hurt them and will try to defend themselves
- **Do not raise your eye-brows** at them and stare – this is a sign of aggression in monkey language – we normally do this when we shout!
- If monkeys scream and **show their teeth** they are not being aggressive – they are **frightened**.
- **Don't lean over a monkey** if they are near you – they think you are about to attack them.
- If a monkey comes near you to '**beg**' for food, use the hose reels provided to spray monkeys.

Pick up any litter and place in monkey proof dustbins provided.
