Play shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of golf published by R&A Rules Limited and the United States Golf Association and the following local rules:

LOCAL RULES:

See notice Boards for any temporary Local Rules.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2) Stroke & Distance

NB: PROPERTIES ADJOINING THE COURSE ARE PRIVATE AND STRICTLY OUT OF BOUNDS. NO ENTRY.

- i. Beyond the nearest inside points at the ground level of white stakes, or any fence post or brick wall surrounding the course and all Estate roads.

2. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16)

- i. As defined by the rules of golf and any area ringed in white or marked G.U.R.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16.1)

A ball may be dropped without penalty in accordance with the procedure in Rule 16.1.

- i. Artificially surfaced cart paths, dirt roads, cycle tracks and bridge structures which lie outside the margins of a penalty area.
- ii. General golf course signage.
- iii. Young trees identified by white stakes.

4. PROMPT PACE OF PLAY (Rule 5.6b)

MECC has adopted the policy of playing out of turn to help pace of play referred to as "Ready Golf" in stroke play competitions and in match play, by prior agreement with your opponent. In doing so players are to act sensibly and responsibly to ensure that playing out of turn does not endanger or disrupt other players.

5. Lightning

It is recommended that play be discontinued if there is lightning in the vicinity. Any decision to commence play in the presence of lightning is taken entirely at your own discretion and risk. MECC will sound the siren to warn players of lightning in the area.
